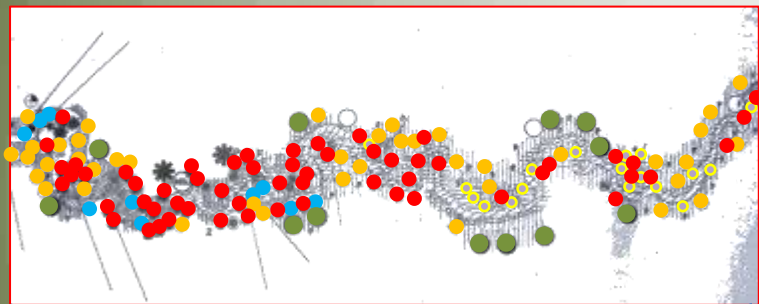

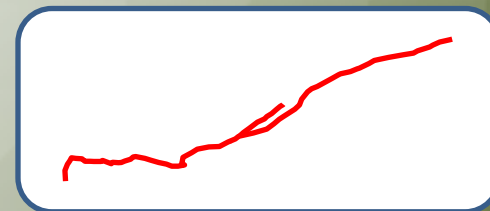

- Pluimzegge *Carex paniculata*, Rispensegge

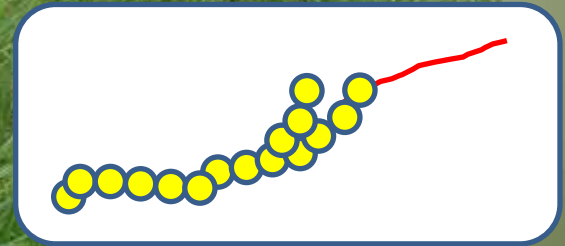

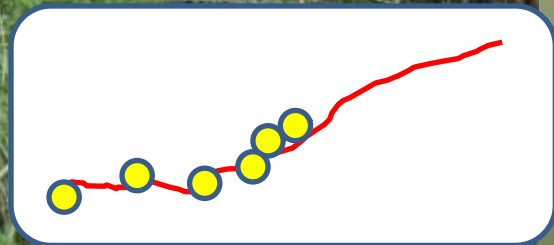

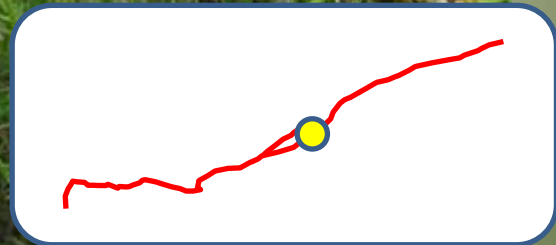

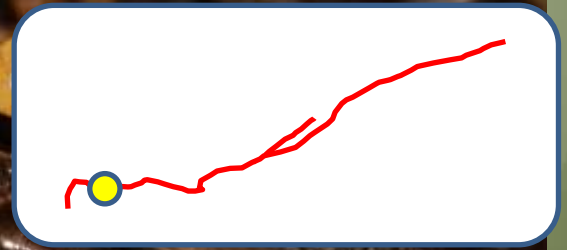

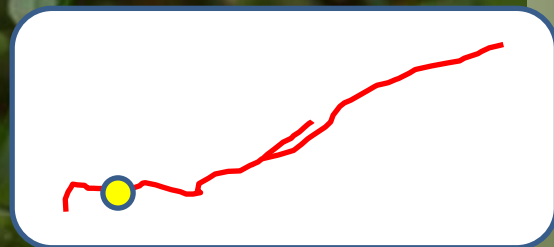

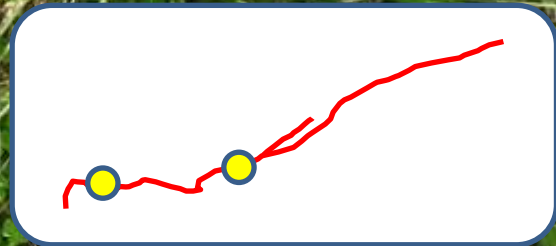

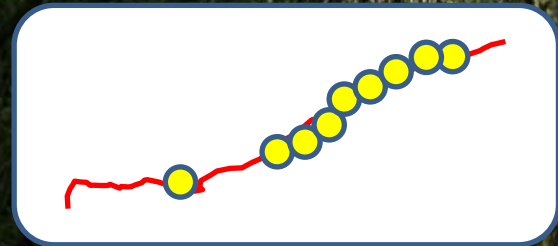

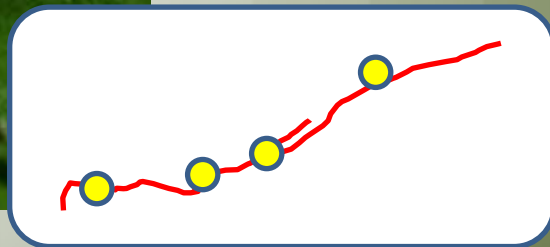

Conclusie

Boschbeek is geomorfologisch een betrekkelijk onbeschonden beekstelsel met bijzondere flora en fauna

- opmerkelijke zeggenvegetaties, lokaal voorkomen bijzondere planten (Bospaardenstaart, Klein glidkruid).
- Een van de laatste habitats in Nederland van de Gewone bronlibel
- Habitat voor specifieke nachtvinders

Grootste bedreiging is toenemende verdroging:

- Verdwijnen van specifieke beekfauna
- Verandering van flora en vegetatie
